

2026-2027 Unusual Enrollment History (UEH): Review Required

Please disregard this notice until you have been fully evaluated by the Office of the Registrar. Once we receive notice that your evaluation has been completed, we will contact you within 48 to 72 hours and update your financial aid document list accordingly.

Your 2026-2027 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) has been flagged by the Department of Education for "Unusual Enrollment History (UEH)." This flag requires Waldorf University to review your enrollment history over the past four award years prior to determining your eligibility to receive any Federal Student Aid (FSA) for the 2026-2027 Award Year. Once your degree program evaluation has been completed by the Registrar's Office, the Office of Financial Aid will review your academic records (i.e. official transcripts) for each institution attended during the last four award years: 2022-2023, 2023-2024, 2024-2025 and 2025-2026.

In order to determine which schools Waldorf University will evaluate for academic credit earned, you can review your entire FSA history via https://nslds.ed.gov/nslds/nslds_SA/. Any schools in which Federal Pell Grant, Subsidized and/or Unsubsidized Loan funds have disbursed during the previously mentioned award years will be applicable for review.

Once your evaluation is complete:

- If you received academic credit(s) at each institution, then you will receive an email confirmation of your FSA eligibility for the 2026-2027 Award Year.
- If you did not earn academic credit(s), you will be contacted by our office requesting additional information.

If you did not earn academic credit(s), you will be required to submit a signed and dated Student Statement to explain why no credit was earned at that school. Acceptable reasons for failure to earn credit should be specific as to timeframe and duration; be of an extreme, urgent, or unexpected nature; and described as concisely as possible. Supporting documents are recommended where available.
