



NSLDS issue to clear

Thank you for completing your FAFSA. Your FAFSA has been received and processed. However, you are receiving this additional notice due to one or more pending correction(s).

“The National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) found your reported Social Security Number (SSN) (Item 8) on their database, but your name (Items 1 and 2) and date of birth (Item 9) did not match. Therefore, this FAFSA form does not contain the financial aid history that is associated with your reported SSN.”

The first thing that you will need to do, is log back into your FAFSA form and double check the Social Security Number that you used. If it is the correct number, we will need a copy of your Social Security Card and a copy of a State Issued ID (generally a Driver's License). Once we have confirmation that it is in fact your social security number, we will contact the NSLDS and begin working with them to resolve this situation. It may also involve further action on your part as well. It depends on what is determined by the NSLDS. Often, an error such as this is as simple as a typographical error and can be resolved very easily.
