

STUDENT ARRIVAL, CHECK-IN & NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

All students (and families) must begin their check-in process in the Waldorf Atrium, located at 106 S. 6th St, Forest City, Iowa (connected to Salveson Hall) to begin the office check-in/move-in process *before* going to their residence hall for verification and to receive their room keys. Students will be sent, by email, the Pre-Arrival Check-In Check List to begin the check-in process over the summer prior to arrival. Students who do not complete the **Pre-Arrival Form** ahead of time will have a delayed check-in process upon arrival.

Meals are provided for students starting at the dinner time (5 p.m.) of your scheduled check-in day. Please plan ahead with built in flexibility with your travels to Forest City, flights and needed transport to campus and/or lodging overnights. We ask that you respect the times and dates and arrive on your assigned date and time. Early arrivals to campus will not be approved. Off hour/late night unexpected arrivals after offices are closed will be assessed a \$50 fee.
