



Veteran Status

Thank you for completing your FAFSA. Your FAFSA has been received and processed. However, you are receiving this additional notice due to one or more pending correction(s).

“The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs did not confirm that you are a qualifying veteran for purposes of receiving federal student aid for the school year. If you believe you are or will be a qualifying veteran, contact your college’s or career school’s financial aid office and provide a copy of your DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty (military separation form). If you are currently serving on active duty in the U.S. armed forces for purposes other than training, select “Make a Correction” to update your information. If you are not and will not be a veteran, you must also correct your information.

For clarification purposes, if you are a member of the National Guard but have not been called to active duty by order of the President of the United States, then for Federal Financial Aid purposes, you are not on active duty and do not qualify to be a veteran.

Once corrections are made, make sure you save and submit those corrections.

Our office will receive your corrected FAFSA in roughly three to five business days. Once received and processed, this need will disappear from your financial aid document list.
